LAS VEGAS STRIP



The Las Vegas airport is conveniently located just off the strip and there are direct flights available from most major US cities. A rental car is not required in Vegas unless you want to do one of the many popular day trips such as the Grand Canyon, the Hoover Dam or Lake Mead. Most of the major hotels offer shuttle

service and a taxi only takes a few minutes. Once you settle in, walking the strip is the main way to get around. There are monorails between a number of hotels, shuttles and buses that run up and down the strip. Experience Paris, Venice, or New York as you travel the strip.

Las Vegas hosts the annual World Series of Poker at the Rio Hotel & Casino. The event runs for the month of June through Mid July and draws the top poker players from around the world to compete in over 50 events. During the World Series many of the other casinos run high quality mini series tournaments that are very popular and have less expensive entry costs. Some of the more popular poker rooms on The Strip can be found at The Venetian, Bellagio, Caesar's Palace, Wynn, MGM Grand and The Mirage. Popular Downtown poker rooms include Binion's Horseshoe

and The Golden Nugget.







Be sure to visit the historic original downtown Las Vegas a couple miles from the main strip on Fremont Street. You'll find some fun old casinos and free entertainment there, as well as great affordable casino dining. The Fremont Street Experience is a



long pedestrian mall that attracts thousands of visitors each day. The free Viva Vision light shows are a must-see in Las Vegas. The Viva Vision canopy stretching over Fremont Street is the world's largest video screen, providing free nightly light shows feature over 12 million lights and 550,000 watts of amazing sound. While there, experience the SlotZilla zip line which features a 12-story, slot machine-inspired launch platform so you can zip over the crowds on Freemont Street under the Viva Vision canopy. At the east end of Fremont Street be sure to visit the nostalgic Neon Museum which hosts some of Las Vegas' historic neon signs.



Towering 1,149 feet above the Vegas skyline, the Stratosphere Tower is the tallest freestanding observation tower in the United State. At the top, you can enjoy the world's highest thrill rides. At 108 stories, the SkyJump is the longest controlled free fall. It's similar to a Bungee Jump but safer as you are on a wire dropping at a more controlled speed. The ride Insanity is a

massive mechanical arm extending out 64 feet over the edge of the Stratosphere Tower and spins you in the air at speeds of up to three 'G's. The ride X-Scream propels you headfirst 27 feet over the edge of the tower. The ride Big Shot will shoot you 160 feet in the air at 45 miles per hour up the tower's mast to a height of 1,081 feet.

At 550 feet high, the High Roller is the world's largest observation Ferris wheel. It's located directly across from Caesar's Palace next to the Flamingo Resort & Casino at the LINQ open air shops & entertainment center. The ride offers spectacular 360 degree views of Las Vegas and



at night the 2,000 LED lights adorning the wheel light up the Vegas Skyline. The High Roller can accommodate 1,120 people at a time. It's equipped with 28 cabins that each accommodates 40 passengers. It takes 30-minutes to complete one full revolution, so the ride is slow and smooth. You can even enjoy a cocktail while on the High Roller as there is a full bar in the waiting area.



FASHION SHOW MALL

Las Vegas is super popular with the fashion shopper. High-end fashion stores with the latest hot trends can be found all throughout the Las Vegas strip. Get your fill of Louis Vuitton, Coach, Dolce & Gabbana, Rolex, Cartier and more at the Forum Shops at Ceasars. Stroll the Miracle Mile Shops at Planet Hollywood or the Grand Canal Shoppes at the Venetian Resort.

Shopping can easily become an all day event. You can even catch a runway fashion show every hour at the Fashion Show Mall across from the Wynn Resort. In Vegas you will find unique selections of designers' premium merchandise, things you just don't see elsewhere. You will even find two premium outlet malls with great bargains.

Along the famous Las Vegas strip (Las Vegas Blvd.) you will find the worlds top mega resort casinos. Each one trying to out do the next and get you in their doors.
