Hiking on these trails is safe as they are well travelled. Manzanillo is generally a very safe city, so you should have no problems walking around. Alternatively to hiking or swimming in the ocean, you could partake in day trips that give you the opportunity to swim in utterly secluded and picturesque lakes and rivers, as well as witnessing, and even swimming beneath some truly mystical waterfalls that are unique to Manzanillo!
